From there, we headed over to the West side of Cincinnati in March, where we teamed up with Compassionate Touch Ministries for an awesome day of ecumenical ministry involving a dozen different denominations. The following weekend we headed to Camp Kirkwood to worship and pray with the women of the Eastgate Vineyard at their annual retreat, and then finished the year in November with the women of Cincinnati Real Life, where we experienced the first vision of the Bride in combat boots (check out the website for pictures).
